
All Apologies- Nirvana

There are two parts to this song: the verse and chorus. The verse only has one chord, C, but also contains a riff. A riff is a short, repeated musical idea that is the musical "hook" for a piece of music. Lot's of rock songs are built around riffs.

Here's the riff for All Apologies:



Here is the strumming for the verse. Notice the strum pattern is the same as for Good Riddance.



The Chorus is below. You can strum as written or vary the strumming as you like. Varying the strumming is sometimes indicated by "ad lib".
